REFORM DAY 31 OCTOBER..

ALL SAINTS DAY 1 NOVEMBER..

In some countries, All Saints Day is an official holiday, with driving bans in effect. For Jan Krediet, this affects route transportation to Belgium, France and Germany. Please allow for possible delays.



CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR..

In week 52 and week 1, there is no international service. This does not apply to our Benelux services, which will have limited availability during these weeks. Our offices and warehouses will be closed on December 25 and 26 and on January 1.

To ensure your goods reach their destination before Christmas, your shipments should reach Jan Krediet no later than the dates listed below.

B2B shipments	Benelux	Friday week 50 at the latest
B2B shipments	Central Europe	Friday week 50 at the latest
B2B shipments	Southern Europe	Friday week 49 at the latest
B2C shipments	Northern Europe	Friday week 49 at the latest
B2C shipments	Southern Europe	Friday week 48 at the latest

Naturally, we will make every effort to find a logistical solution for your goods even outside the set deadlines. We are happy to do this in consultation, taking into account that various depots apply the first-in first-out principle around the Christmas period and have volume restrictions.
